French Dual-Language Immersion

In 2022-2023 the District will continue the Evansdale dual language immersion articulation by expanding the program at Lakeside High School to include 9th grade.

The district implements a 50/50 immersion model. Students study math, science, social studies and literacy in French. Using English, the students will study literacy, social studies and receive math, science and social studies support. In the middle school, students study Advanced Language and Literacy and World Studies.

The immersion program provides important benefits to students in the areas of cognition, achievement, and linguistics. Students will possess a skill that creates a professional competitive advantage, making them more attractive to colleges, career and technical programs, and employers.
